The New York State Education Department (NYSED) is preparing to calculate 2024-25 ESSA Title III allocations to Local Education Agencies (LEAs) and Immigrant

The following timeline has been established:

Beginning the week of May 6, 2024 through the weekend of June 7, 2024

- x LEAs review ELL counts by district and charter school in Level 2 of

Charter school student data in their local student management systems and ensure that the revised data are loaded into Level 2 of the SIRS by June 7, 2024. Local Level 1 data centers will require data to be submitted earlier than June 7 in order to allow sufficient time for processing.

- x Public ELL and Immigrant counts by district and charter school in Level 2 of the SIRS and nonpublic school ELL and Immigrant counts by district in BEDS on June 10, 2024 will be used for 2024-25 Title III ELL allocations.
