# Y10 Pooling: Process, Form & Instructions Office of Religious & Independent School Support (ORISS) Nonpublic School Safety Equipment (NPSE)

## **Pooling Eligibility**

#### What is Pooling?

Pooling of funds is used when related agencies have collaborative items/services and wish to combine their allocations. Pooling is optional and most schools do not participate in pooling.

#### Who can Pool?

Only eligible schools may elect to pool. Pooled funding is limited to those schools who share a Payee address. Information on how to access and/edit an institution's Payee Names/Addresses can be found in the Y10 NPSE Application Instructions. An institution who's submitted an application for the Y10 NPSE claim cycle would not be eligible to pool.
