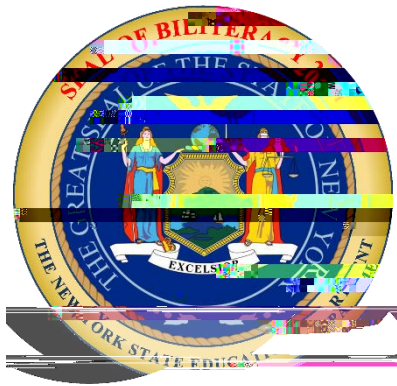


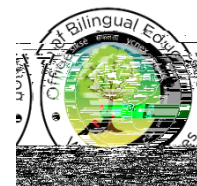

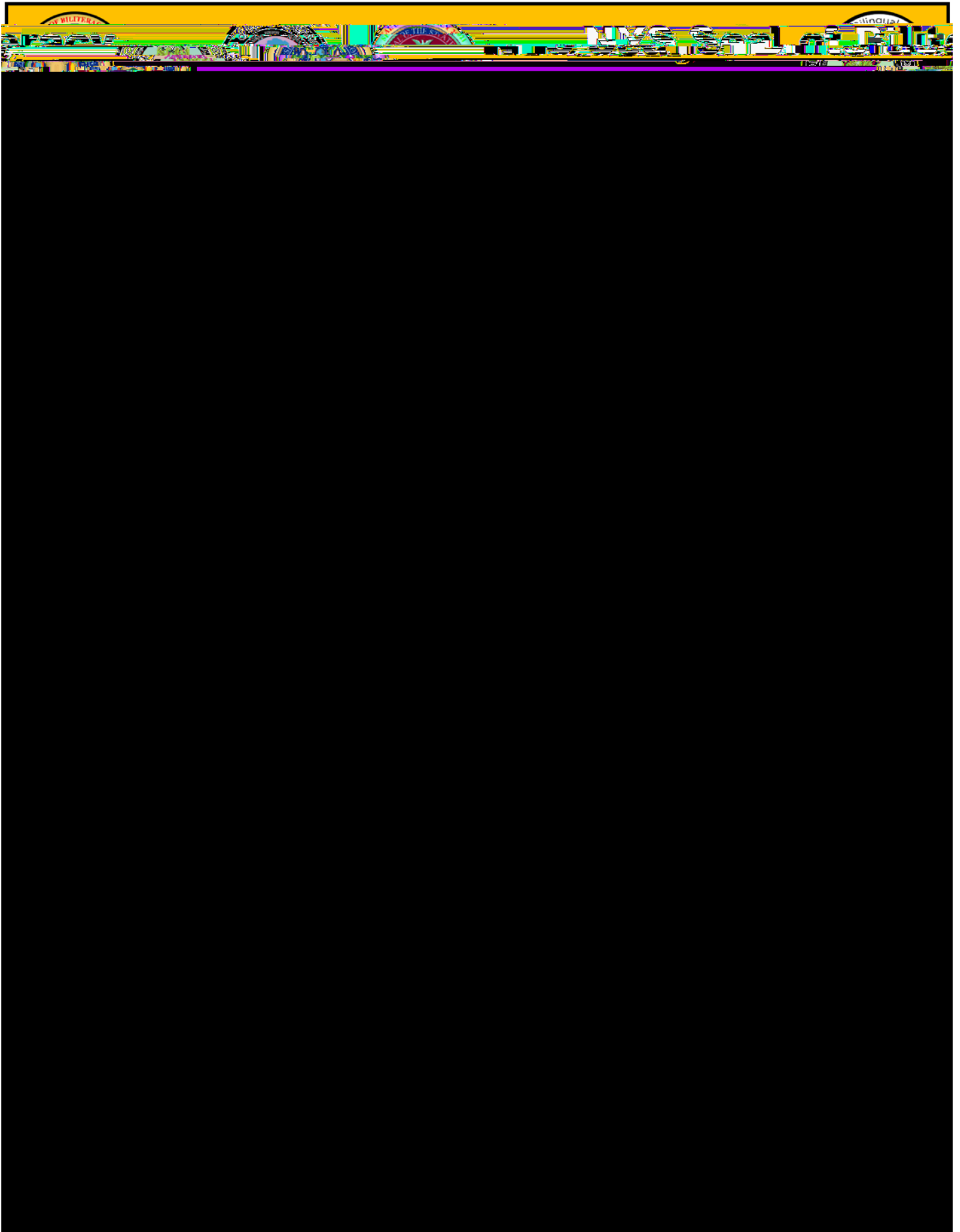

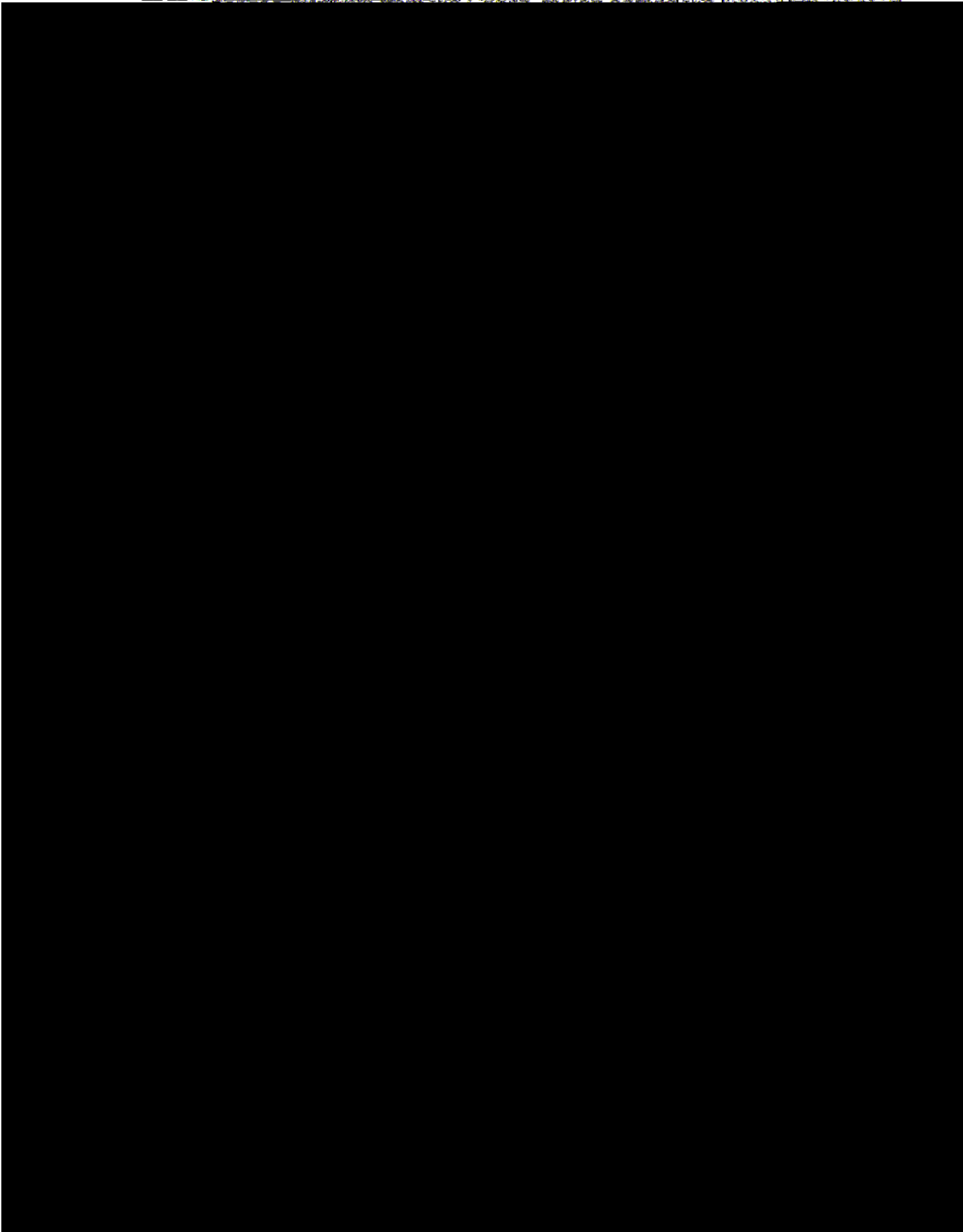

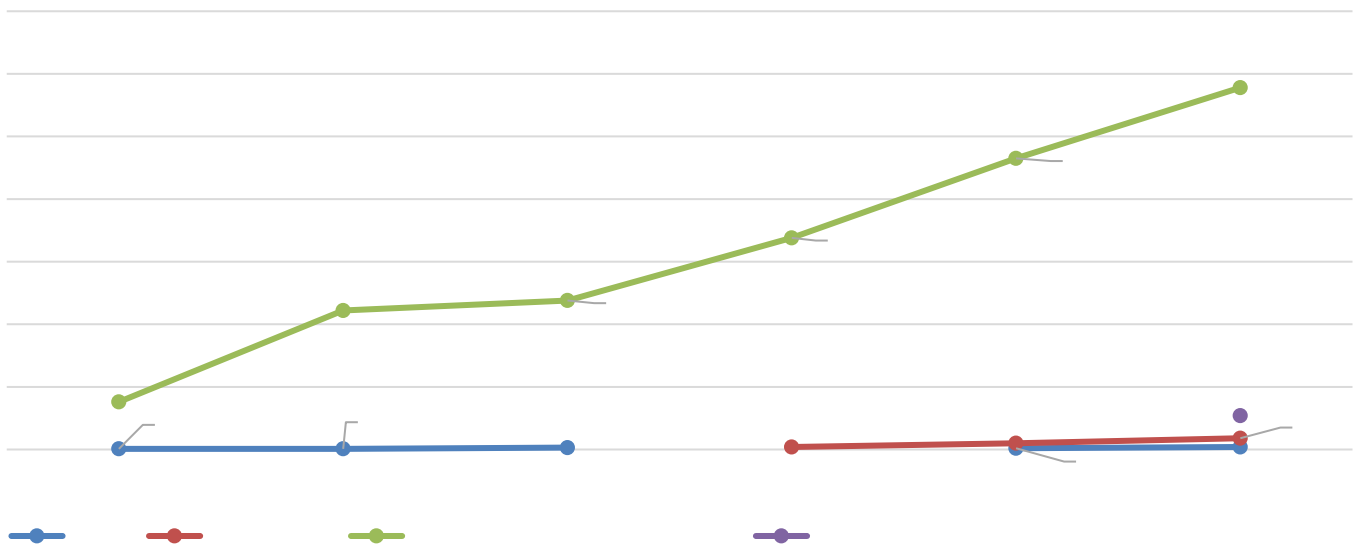
Figure 8. Number of Students Awarded the NYSSB in the Capital by Gender (2020-2021)

Figure 12. Number of Students who Earned the NYSSB in the Capital Region by World Language (2016-2021)

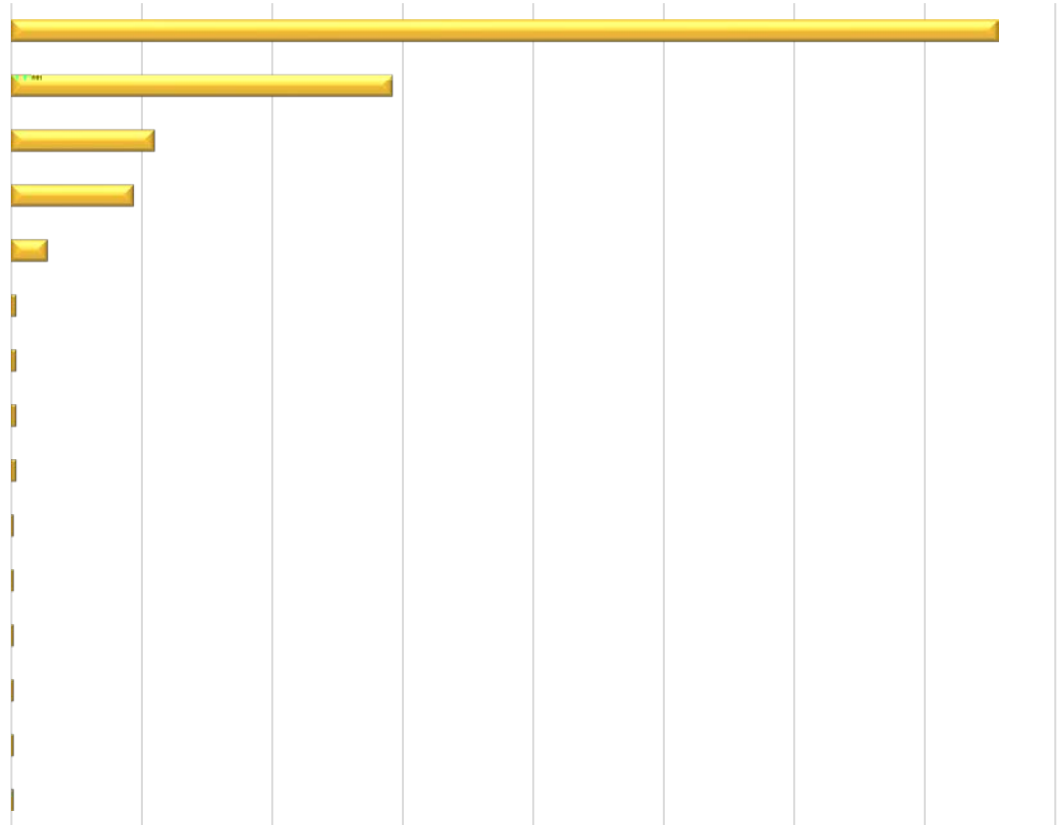
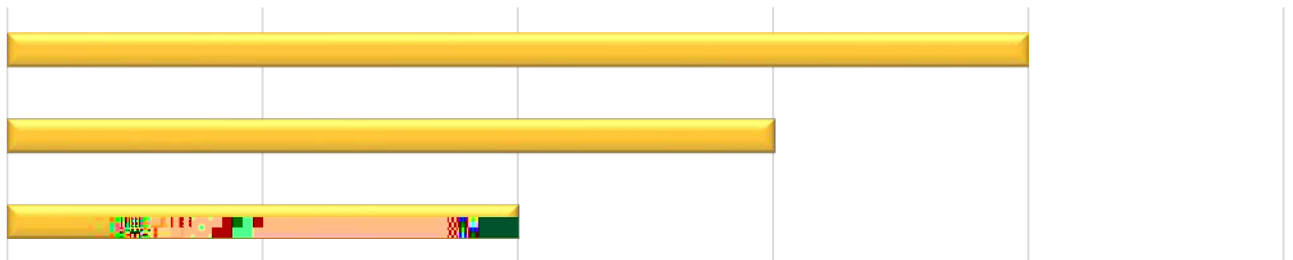


Figure 13. Number of Students Who Earned the NYSSB in the Capital Region in Two World Languages in Addition to English (2021)
